Playbuilding Towards Performance

Upper Primary, Secondary, JC/Cl Students

- Create a dramatised performance using an allocated text as the stimulus.
- Develop speech skills, understand the fundamental elements of drama.
- Discover inventiveness and ingenuity through the exposure to literary devices such as metaphors and imagery.
- Consider different elements of drama that aid in creating an effective play.
- Learn non-verbal communication through use of their bodies as signs and images.
- Focus on production creation and the construction of an ensemble with a united sense of rhythm and flow.

Digital Storytelling Secondary Students

- Students will work towards creating a 3-5 minute video end product based on a given theme. Their scripts will be edited and proof-read, applying techniques of good presentation skills in their story-telling. Finally, their videos will be refined, finalised for their presentation to review.
- Develop writing, linguistic and presentation skills, leveraging on ICT as a teaching tool to promote Self-Directed Learning.
- Learn to organise ideas for specific writing purpose and use language to enhance fluency and expressiveness in their presentation.

Forum Theatre Workshop

Upper Primary, Secondary, JC/Cl Students

- This programme will incorporate Design Thinking tools into the idea generation for solving a problem. Students will be able to articulate ideas and apply the skills in critical thinking.
- Learn to develop empathy and creative problem-solving skills by leveraging on forum theatre as a teaching tool to promote taking ownership of issue.
- They will also role play in shaping the solution to the problem and propose ideas and take action towards better solutions.

Design Thinking for Service-Learning Workshops Secondary Students

- Students will be working in groups of 4-5 to formalise that as a proposal to pitch their ideas towards Friend of Singa (under Singapore Kindness Movement).
- Stand a chance to secure some funding to execute their projects for their social advocacy campaign.
- Explore Design Thinking with role-playing from Forum Theatre, dialoguing and reflection as primary methodologies.

Leadership Odyssey Camp Secondary / JC Students

- A 3-Day Orientation Camp to Build Leaders of Tomorrow through Innovation and Creativity!
- Using the Leadership Challenge Model, students will embark on a camp that builds leadership potential to face challenges, encouraging change-makers who envision their future by actively contributing to it.
- Undergo activities that introduce and develop experiential learning skills, design thinking applications, forum theatre skills, interpersonal and collaboration techniques.

Innovative Drama & Secondary Students **Communication Programme**

 Learn how to communicate effectively through a holistic programme that covers constructing and delivering presentations, developing vocal prowess, engaging and captivating audiences through compelling speeches, and crafting structured responses.

Directing Collaborative Theatre Middle Primary, Upper Primary, Secondary, JC/CI Students

- Students will be introduced to the nature of collaborative theatre.
- Be exposed to several devices used to generate material for devised theatre.
- Use Process Drama to develop values and social emotional learning.
- Students will present a mini staging of a devised moment, artist statement and performance (15-20 min) inspired from the stimulus provided.

Stagecraft

Middle Primary, Upper Primary, Secondary, JC/Cl Students

- Introduction to Technical Theatre, Stagecraft and production techniques.
- Develop a comprehensive understanding as well as provide practical knowledge of what goes on behind the stage in theatre productions.
- Students will be introduced to drama through improvisation and dramatic performance as part of the program.
- Another separate phase of workshop will introduce them to the application of Stagecraft to their performance.

Drama 101 - Drama for Beginners Primary, Secondary Students

- Learn through improvisation and structured dramatic role-play
- Use imagination-expanding exercises in Pantomime, Voice and Improvisations that are adaptable to School Values or any chosen context.
- Discover their imaginative potential through these forms and practice communication in an active, dramatic and immediate context.
- Play out and reflect upon issues that are beyond the typical classroom experience.
